

HAYULIMA'S VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

The volunteer program has three possibilities:

Duration for 1 month. - You can be part of our house during a month while sharing your knowledge with others. Your responsibility lies on keeping the space clean, cleaning the guest's houses, bathrooms, kitchen, help in the kitchen chores for 2 hours, daily, preparing food, washing dishes, etc. Helping in the ceremonial spaces, cleaning the temple, keeping blankets, mattresses and altars clean.

Duration for 3 months. - The same as the first month, plus helping in the vegetable gardens, preparation of medicines, etc. By staying longer with us you will also be able to offer your help when we prepare the sacred medicine that will be served during the ceremonies, the maintenance of houses and construction of sacred spaces.

Duration for 6 months. - Your work has the same responsibilities as the other two mentioned above, including specific projects where you could support the development of the spiritual house. For example, if you are an architect you could help in the garden design, or if you are a bio-constructor you could help with the building of rooms for guests, work in keeping a sustainable energy use, collection and use of water, design and construction of spaces for children, design and construction of spaces for workshops, among others, as Community Support projects.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Curriculum Vitae (max one page)
- 2. Work experience
- 3. Portfolio with pictures of your work.
- 4. A clear picture of yourself.
- 5. A quick explanation about why you would like to be a Hayulima, Sacred Spiritual Sanctuary, volunteer. Explain if you have any previous experience with the use of power plants and traditions.
- 6. Medical exams, explain if you have any illness or if you are taking medications.
- 7. Specify the amount of time that you wish to volunteer, be it 1, 3 or 6 months.
- 8. Contact for personal references (e-mail, phone number, etc)
